Primary Objectives

Role	<p>Perform works on the planning, scheduling, risk management, roading, harvesting and coupe regeneration operations in line with legislative requirements and business objectives. Also, the role will contribute to the development of Tactical Plans through remote and field resource assessment and facilitation of regulatory approval of Timber Release Plans.</p>

Key Result Areas

The KRA's are the major outputs for which the position is responsible for and are not a comprehensive statement of the position activities. You may, however, be required to undertake other duties and responsibilities from time to time, in addition to or as variations of the duties and responsibilities of the position.

- Coordinate preparation of coupes for harvest, including; preparation of the coupe plan, field marking boundaries and undertaking biodiversity field inspections and management of special values at the coupe level
- Supervise contractors, including; auditing contractors' compliance, managing production against schedule and undertaking log grading
- Coordinate road maintenance and road building operations and associated logistical arrangements as well as roadline planning and marking
- Perform works on the preparation, implementation and monitoring of a range of plans and programs associated with forest regeneration, including seed collection, mechanical disturbance, regeneration burning, survey work and coupe handover
- Perform works on the Rolling Operations Plans by coordinating contractors to coupes in line with contractual obligations and sales commitments
- Collate monthly coupe production estimates by contractor, integrating this into the Sales Operations and Planning Process (SOP)
- Work on the process of ensuring coupes are risk-assured and ready to log, including assessing all coupes for management issues, and contribute to assigning management actions to these in line with codes of practice, regulations, prescriptions and other relevant legislation
- Work on the preparation and collation of final logging history data to produce slope and yield advice for coupes post-harvest reconciliation
- Coordinate the delivery of biodiversity survey programs and associated outcomes
- Deliver inventory/reconnaissance programs, carrying out detailed investigations of defined areas to determine strategies for accessing, harvesting and regeneration
- Ensure inventory/reconnaissance data is appropriately stored and mapped in line with business requirements, meeting all team targets
- Liaise with VicForests staff, DELWP and stakeholders in regard to coupe specific issues
- Perform fire suppression activities in conjunction with DELWP
- Contribute to the optimisation of individual and team performance through training, development and performance management
- Support VicForests participation in audit and investigation programs and analysis of outcomes to assist in identifying and implementing opportunities for improvement
- Coordinate auditing programs undertaken on contractors, including equipment and haulage compliance audits, and analyse outcomes to identify and implement opportunities for improvement
- Undertake any duties and responsibilities to meet the requirements of the team or broader business
- Perform duties in a manner that ensures the health and safety of yourself and others. Ensure that all incidents and hazards are reported in a timely manner
- Take responsibility for performing the role in accordance with all relevant system requirements
- Identify and communicate key risks and ensure risk management processes are followed
